These wonderful little machines bring us all together at events, circuits and car shows up and down the country where they are driven enthusiastically by their creators to entertain themselves and those who marvel at the wayside. Cyclekarts remind us of bygone years where pioneering engineers hand built machines to take racing on the weekends in the pursuit of adventure.

One thing is for sure, they make people smile and that just has to be good for the soul.



THE NEW/OLD MOTORSPORT ON THE BLOCK!

Cyclekarts are compact, lightweight, 2/3 scale sports machines, hand made by their drivers for the pursuit of classic motorsport excitement and styled to resemble race cars from the 1920's and 1930's.

The interest in Cyclekarts has grown tremendously recently in the UK and across the globe with new clubs starting all the time. Cyclekarts originated in America and the scene in the states is much larger, but we currently have approximately 20 completed active vehicles with many many more 'in build'.

Cyclekarts should be an expression of the owner's individual styling interests as well as sharing the pride in building one's own unique looking kart. They are not built to be serious race machines or show cars.

What drives them?

Primarily, the enthusiasm of their builders. We use a 200cc 4 Stroke Engine between 6.5HP and 10HP, Automatic transmission, 17" wheels from a HONDA C90 or PIT BIKE and lots of common GO-Kart parts. The most important thing is to make it look good with the styling of a suitable inspiration car.

Where do we drive them?

The CycleKartsGB club runs events throughout the year at several tracks that include grass, concrete and tarmac surfaces. We are often invited to show or drive at events such as:
